Online Applications are invited from the intending eligible candidates for appearing in the Dibrugarh University Post Graduate Entrance Test (DUPGET), 2025 for admission to the following academic Programmes conducted by Dibrugarh University and its Affiliated and Autonomous Colleges in the Academic Session 2025- 2026:

Candidates passed the qualifying examination in CBCS must have studied minimum 24 Credits in the subject applied for admission.

*Besides the above-

- a. Candidates appeared/appearing in the 6th Semester B.A., B.Sc., B. Com Examinations, 2025 and waiting for their results are eligible to appear in the DUPGET 2025 and can get provisional admission if selected.
- b. Candidates appeared/ appearing in the Final Semester Examinations and waiting for results but have backlog in 2nd and/or 4th Semester Examinations are also eligible to appear in the DUPGET 2025 and can get provisional admission if selected.

*However, the above mentioned candidates shall have to submit the Final Gradesheet/ Marksheet within a stipulated date to be decided by the University.

1) Conduct of DUPGET, 2025 for Selection of Candidates

- a) The DUPGET 2025 is conducted by the Dibrugarh University Post Graduate Entrance Test (DUPGET) Board, Dibrugarh University.
- b) The DUPGET 2025 shall be conducted for all candidates for the academic programmes mentioned below irrespective of the University they have passed the qualifying examination. The Subjects are-
 - MA. in: Anthropology, Assamese, Bodo, Economics, History, Sociology, Statistics, Geography, Education, English, Mathematics, Political Science, Philosophy, Applied Psychology, Mass Communication, Women's Studies
 - M.Sc. in: Anthropology, Applied Geology, Life Sciences (Zoology), Life Sciences (Botany), Physics, Statistics, Geography, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biotechnology and Bioinformatics

M.Com. in: (i) Finance and (ii) Marketing



Notification for some other Post Graduate, Under Graduate, Diploma and Certificate Programmes have already been notified or will be notified separately.

2) Selection Criteria for Admission through DUPGET 2025:

- a) For 80% of seats, reserved for the students graduated from Dibrugarh University, shall be selected on the merit of the DUPGET 2025 (i.e. the weightage of DUPGET 2025 shall be of 100%) in addition to the fulfillment of minimum eligibility criteria.
- b) For the 20% of the seats reserved for the graduates of all recognized Universities other than Dibrugarh University, the candidates shall also be selected on the merit of the DUPGET 2025 only subject to the fulfillment of minimum eligibility criteria.
- c) A Candidate is eligible to appear in the DUPGET 2025 in maximum 4 (four) subjects. Moreover, they should not apply in *more than 1 (one) subject* from the same Shift as given below-



- Shift 1: Anthropology, Applied Geology, Chemistry, Education, English, History, Mathematics
- **Shift 2:** Assamese, Bodo, Biotechnology and Bioinformatics, Philosophy, Political Science, M.T.T.M.
- Shift 3: Applied Psychology, Economics, Geography, Life Sciences (Botany), Life Sciences (Zoology), M.Ed., Physics, Statistics,
- Shift 4: M.Com. in (i) Finance and (ii) Marketing, Mass Communication, M.C.A., Sociology, Women's Studies.

3) Nature of the DUPGET:

- a) The Question Paper shall be in English excluding the language subjects.
- b) For all the subjects (Except for Mathematics subject)
 - i) The DUPGET shall be of 100 Marks and of 2 (two) hours duration.
 - ii) It shall be conducted in a single paper of the concerned subject containing 100 Objective Type Multiple Choice questions (MCQ) carrying 1 (one) mark each.
 - iii) There shall be a provision of negative marking of 0.25 (point two five) mark for incorrect response to a question.
- c) For Mathematics subject, DUPGET shall be of 150 marks of 2 (two) hours duration containing 75 Objective Type Multiple Choice questions (MCQ) carrying 2 (two) mark each. There shall be a provision of negative marking of 0.5 (point five) mark for incorrect response to a question in Mathematics.
- d) The candidate shall be required to appear the DUPGET in the OMR Sheet and the evaluation process shall be done by the automated electronically operated system.
- The DUPGET score shall be valid for admission in the current academic session 2025-2026 only.
- f) For any other details regarding DUPGET 2025, please see the relevant Ordinance (Annexure-A).

iii. How to Apply:

- Application for appearing in the DUPGET 2025 shall be through online mode only. No other means of application shall be accepted.
- 2. Online Registration for submission of Application Form will begin from 08.05.2025. Application for DUPGET 2025 is through online mode only. The last date for submission of application is 26.05.2025 (till 11.55 p.m.)
- 3. For submission of the Online Application Form, intending candidates are advised to follow the following instructions:
 - a) The candidate shall be required to visit the DUPGET 2025 Portal in the websitewww.dibru.ac.in.
 - The Candidate needs to register on the portal by clicking the "Register" button and providing his/her name, mobile number and a password. The mobile number will be verified through an OTP. Please remember the password for login.
 - c) After successful registration, the candidate needs to login using his/her mobile number and the password.
 - After login, the candidate needs to click on the "Apply" button corresponding to the link of "DUPGET 2025" which will lead to an application form. The candidate needs to fill up the application form step by step.
 - After filling-up the Form, Candidate needs to click the button "Submit and Review". A preview of the filled-up form will be displayed. Candidates are advised to carefully cross-check the information and if anything needs to be corrected at this stage, they can go back and edit.

- f) After ensuring that all the information displayed on the Preview is correct, the candidate needs to click 'Pay now & Submit the application" and the pay the application fee of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One Thousand) only through online mode (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking).
- g) The application form will be considered finally submitted only when the application fee is successfully paid by the candidate and an online receipt is generated confirming the payment.
- h) There will be a button to download the Application Form and Admit Card for future reference.
- The Candidate shall have to take a print out of the Admit Card and bring the same to the Examination Hall on the Date of the Test for verification.
- j) The Submission of Online Application Forms shall be automatically closed after the last date.

 Important Note: The University shall not verify the eligibility of a candidate at the time of receiving their Application Forms and Issuing Admit Cards to them. The candidates not fulfilling the minimum eligibility may appear in the DUPGET, 2025. However, their candidature shall not be considered at the time of admission to the concerned Post Graduate Programmes conducted by Dibrugarh University and its

iv. Selection procedure:

affiliated colleges.

- a. 80% of the total seats in each subject under M.A./M.Sc./ M.Com. Programmes only (excluding M.C.A., M.T.T.M. and a few programmes to be notified later on) are reserved for the graduates of the affiliated/ permitted/ autonomous colleges/ institutes of Dibrugarh University.
- b. Remaining 20% of seats shall be filled up by the eligible candidates belonging to all recognized Universities **excluding** Dibrugarh University.
- c. For all candidates, appearing in DUPGET 2025 is mandatory.
- d. The Candidates securing marks in the DUPGET 2025 in higher order shall get preference to take admission in to the relevant Programme in Dibrugarh University and in the Affiliated/ Autonomous Colleges according to their preferences.
- e. As the Selection of Eligible Candidates for admission to the Post Graduate Programmes shall be done only on the basis the DUPGET 2025, the selection and admission shall be purely provisional and subject to production of relevant documents of passing the qualifying examinations with requisite norms before the concerned Department/ Centre for Studies/ College where he/ she has taken admission. An Undertaking shall also be taken from the admitted students in this regard.
- f. Statutory Reservation and Relaxation Policy shall be followed as per the Government Rules by the University and its Affiliated/ Autonomous Colleges while preparing the Merit List of the Candidates.

In case of Academic Programmes conducted by the Teaching Departments/ Centres of Studies, the Dibrugarh University Reservation and Relaxation Rules for Admission into Post Graduate, Under Graduate, Advanced Post Graduate Diploma, Post Graduate Diploma, Diploma and Certificate Programmes (Revised upto February 2022) shall be applicable in selecting the eligible candidates under different non-statutory reservation categories.

The Prescribed Form is given with this Notification.

The Candidates seeking admission under (i) Differently Abled and (ii) Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) categories shall have to submit their documents at the Office of the concerned Teaching Department or Centre of Studies on or before 20.06.2025 by 5:00 pm along with a print copy of the Online Admission Form of DUPGET 2025.

- c) The admission and other fees to be paid at the time of admission shall be received through online payment system. The University shall guide the candidates for payment of their fees.
