General Information

1. The Joint MCA Entrance Examination (JMEE), 2025 for admission to 1st Semester MCA Programme in the colleges of the State of Assam shall be conducted by the Assam Science & Technology University (ASTU).
2. The Programme of the examination is as follows:

4. Candidates should note the following:

Paper shall be of three (3) hours duration for the examination and shall contain 100 multiple choice questions each carrying equal marks. Four (4) marks will be awarded for every right answer and one (1) mark will be deducted for every wrong answer. Option once marked cannot be changed and erased. **The examination will be Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) Type and comprise of a Single Paper of three (3) hours duration with the following distribution:**

a)	Mathematics	30 Questions
b)	Reasoning	30 Questions
c)	English	20 Questions
d)	Fundamentals of Computers	20 Questions

5. Candidates must apply through online application form. Candidates are advised to read the Instructions for filling up the online Application Form. The applicants must possess the required criteria and educational qualification as mentioned in the Information Brochure, failing which candidature shall be disqualified at the time of counseling, if called for.
6. **Steps and precautions to be taken while filling up of application form for JMEE-2025**
 - a) A computer with good internet connectivity.
 - b) A recent passport size colored photograph of the candidate should be uploaded in the space indicated in the Online Application Form. **Size of photograph must be less than 35 kb, height of the photograph between 250 pixels to 320 pixel and width of the photograph must be between 150 pixel to 220 pixel. Size of the signature must be less than 35kb, height of the signature must be between 100 pixels to 180 pixel and width of the signature must be between 150 pixels to 220**

pixel. The photograph and signature should be either in '.jpeg' or '.jpg' format.

- c) Scanned clear signature in JPG/JPEG format (size between 4 kb–30kb).
- d) A valid e-mail Id as all communication will be made on this e-mail Id.
- e) A valid mobile number as all information via SMS will be sent to this number.
- f) A valid debit/credit card or Net banking account.
- g) A printer connected to your system to print confirmation page.
- h) Download Information Brochure. Read it carefully to ensure your eligibility and acquaint with the requirements for submission of Online Application Form.
- i) No correction can be made after submission of an application. No change will be accepted through Post/Fax/ email / By hand etc. No change in the category will be entertained after the last date of JMEE-2025 application form submission and no subsequent change will be effective after JMEE-2025 Result declaration.

7. Important Note:

- a) All the candidates who will submit the online application and pay the examination fee till last date will be allowed to appear in JMEE-2025 and their admit cards will be uploaded on the website as per schedule. The University neither verify the information filled by the candidates in the application form nor verify any certificate of category/educational qualification for deciding the eligibility of candidates. The certificates of educational qualification and category (if applied under reserved category) will be verified by the concerned counselling authority.
- b) The candidates are, therefore, advised to ensure their eligibility and the category (if applying under reserved category). The University will, in no way, be responsible for any wrong/incorrect information furnished by the candidate(s) in their online application form. The letter/e-mails in this regard will not be entertained by the University.
- c) Candidates are advised to report at the Examination Center well in time i.e. as per the reporting time mentioned in the admit card.
- d) Candidates can download their score card only through the website <https://www.astu.ac.in> No score card will be dispatched to the candidates.
- e) Assam Science and Technology University will not conduct counseling of the JMEE-2025. ASTU is authorized only to conduct the examination. However, candidates are advised to collect information regarding total no. of seats available in the institutions or the eligibility and reservation criteria etc. from the Director of Technical Education, Govt. of Assam, if required.
- f) Reservations and guidelines of counseling will be as per the Govt. of Assam and AICTE rules and regulations
- g) Candidates are advised to visit ASTU website <https://www.astu.ac.in> regularly for

latest information. ASTU is not responsible for any information related to JMEE-2025 (examination), provided in any other website or social media platforms.

- h) For any technical problem related to Online Application form Submission for JMEE-2025, candidates may immediately contact at Helpdesk Contact Number (displayed on application portal).

8. Applicants need not to send copy of Application Form or any Document to this office. However, candidates should take printout of the application form to be produced during counseling.

Follow the link provided to understand the payment process after submitting the online application Form.

Please note that if any mistake is detected after submission of Online Application, it cannot be rectified by the University. The Assam Science and Technology University shall not be responsible for rejection of candidature at the time of counseling due to non-fulfillment of eligibility criteria and/or wrong entry of information in the online application form. However, the candidate can edit the data in the application upto the last date of the submission of application. Only applications of those candidates who have submitted the requisite fee on or before the last day of payment will be accepted.

9. After depositing requisite fee, print out of the application form may be taken by using application form number/user name and the password given by the candidate. Please remember the password given by you during the submission of Online Application. It is important for further login.
10. Candidate must note/remember his/her individual application id/password etc. for future reference.
11. Candidates should note that OMR Answer Sheet shall have to be used for indicating the answers. The evaluation of the OMR sheets shall be done with the help of computer. No manual evaluation of OMR sheets shall be done. A replica of the OMR Answer sheet to be used is given in Annexure-A. Candidates should familiarize themselves with the use of OMR answer sheet. While appearing in the Examination, candidates should follow the instructions given in the Question Booklet, OMR Answer sheet and carefully fill up the relevant particulars like Roll No, Question Booklet Series Code (A/B/C/D) etc.

Use only BLACK BALL PEN while filling up the OMR sheet.

Since OMR sheets will be used and the evaluation shall be done by computer, there shall be no provision for manual re-checking and re-evaluation

12. Admit Card:

The Candidate will be able to download his/her admit card from the University website www.astu.ac.in from 12th June, 2025 onwards by entering his/her Application Form

number/User name and Password generated during the online submission of Application Form. Discrepancy in Admit Card generated, if any, will be entertained till 18th June, 2025. The issue of Admit Card enables the candidate to appear in the Examination only and does not imply that the candidate satisfies all the requirements to be eligible for admission to the course for which the candidate has appeared in the examination. The eligibility for the selection into a course shall be governed by the rules framed for respective courses.

13. Medium of Entrance Test

The question paper contains questions in “English”.

14. Eligibility for Admission

To be eligible for Admission to any of the Colleges a candidate must fulfill the following conditions: -

- (a) The Candidate must be an Indian Citizen. (With a valid PRC of Assam issued by the competent authority).

Note: candidates who do not have a Permanent Resident Certificate of Assam, on the day of reporting will be given a 30-day time period from the date of reporting to submit the PRC. An undertaking will be taken from the candidate mentioning that failing to submit the PRC after that, his/her seat will be forfeited.

- (b) Age between 20 years to 26 years on 1st day of July 2025.
- (c) Recognized Bachelor’s Degree of Minimum 3 years’ duration with Mathematics at 10+2 level or at Graduation. The candidates must pass Mathematics as one of the subjects at 10+2 level or at Graduation.
- (d) Candidate must secure a minimum of 50% (45% in case of candidate belonging to reserved category) marks in the Graduation.
- Note: i) reserved category includes (OBC/MOBC) NCL/ SC/ST (H)/ST (P).
ii) Candidates must submit their (OBC/MOBC) NCL/EWS/TFW certificate on the date of reporting. Failure to do so will result in the cancellation of their seat for that counselling round. Furthermore, they will be considered as Unreserved (UR) category and candidates will be considered for the next round.
- (e) For candidates whose 6th Semester result is awaited, they must secure 50% (45% in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) marks till the 5th semester without backlog. Candidates will have to give an undertaking that he/she shall be able to produce the final Mark Sheet/ Certificate within 2(two) months of taking admission.
- (f) The candidate must have a valid rank in the Entrance Examination (JMEE-2025) for admission.
- (g) The Candidate must possess a good moral character.

15. Fee Structure

An Application Fee of Rs. 2000/- (Two thousand only) is to be paid online by using **SBI**

Collect which facilitates payment through Debit Card/ Credit Card/ Net Banking. Assam Science and Technology University shall not accept hard copy of the Application and any other documents. **Examination fee, once paid, is not refundable.**

Candidates must make successful online fee payment within the last date of submission of online applications. Otherwise his/her candidature will not be considered for examination. No communication regarding failure of payment, received after the last date of submission of online applications, will be entertained.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

Note: Following instructions are for ready reference to candidates. However, changes in instruction or modifications, if any, will be notified prior to examination.

Candidate must read all the instructions carefully:

1. All Candidates must bring Admit Card, BLACK INK BALL-POINT PEN and a valid photo Identity proof such as Admit card/ Registration card etc. or photo identity cards issued by the Government Authority as a proof of identity inside the Examination Hall.
2. No candidate will be allowed to appear in the Examination without the Admit Card and it must be produced before the Invigilator as and when required.
3. Candidates should enter into the examination hall at least 30 minutes before the scheduled examination time. No candidate will be allowed to leave the Examination Hall during the examination hours. Examination Centre Gate will be closed at 10.30 A.M.
4. Calculators, watches (both analogue and digital) cell phones or any electronic gadget or any objectionable materials, erasers (solid or liquid), books, paper etc. are strictly prohibited in the Examination Hall. Possession of any such item in the examination hall will make the candidate liable for disqualification of candidature.
5. After receiving the OMR sheet, the candidate must report to the invigilator immediately if the information details printed on the OMR Answer sheet mismatch with the information printed on the Admit Card or OMR Answer Sheet is damaged.

Please note that there will be only one OMR Answer-Sheet with preprinted Roll No., Name, and photo of the candidate, for all the questions. No extra OMR Answer- Sheet will be provided for any mistake or correction. Before use of the OMR Answer Sheet, the candidate has to ensure that the information contained in the OMR Answer Sheet are related to him/her only.

6. Candidate must correctly enter the Question Booklet Series Code and Question Booklet No. in the appropriate place of OMR Answer Sheet.
7. The Candidate shall sign and also put his/her Left-Hand Thumb Impression on the i) Attendance Sheet, ii) Admit Card, and iii) OMR Answer Sheet. The candidate shall sign in the same way as s/he uploaded during submission of the Online Application, as appeared in the Admit Card.

8. a) Candidate should read the question carefully and finalize the answer before darkening the correct answer in the appropriate circle of the OMR Answer-Sheet.
- b) Candidate should not make any stray marking on the OMR Answer-Sheet.
- c) Scratching, overwriting, tick marking etc. considered as invalid answer.
- d) Candidate should not staple, fold, pin, wrinkle or damage the OMR Answer-Sheet.
- e) Multiple answering will be considered as wrong answer.
- f) Incorrectly darken answer will be counted as invalid.
- g) Candidate shall not do any rough work in the OMR Answer-Sheet. If any Rough Work is done on the OMR Answer-Sheet, then the OMR Answer-Sheet will not be assessed.
- h) Candidate shall fill the details of the Question Booklet, such as Question Booklet No., Question Booklet Series Code, etc. in the OMR Answer-Sheet carefully.
9. Candidate must note that the OMR Answer sheets are read electronically. Therefore, only one circle/bubble, either (A), (B), (C) or (D) is to be darkened completely by only **BLACK INK BALL POINT PEN** for each answer on the OMR Answer Sheet.

The examination conducting authority shall not be responsible for any mistake made by the candidate while filling in information in the OMR Answer Sheet. OMR Answer sheet shall not be replaced under any circumstances, except OMR Answer sheet is damaged and reported by the candidate at the time of distribution of OMR Answer Sheet, within first 5 minutes of receiving.

10. Candidates are required to read carefully the instructions mentioned in the First Page (Cover Page) of the Question Booklet and OMR Answer Sheet.
11. a) There are altogether- 100 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs).
 - b) Please check the total number of Questions. In case of any discrepancy observed in this regard, please inform the Invigilator for replacement of the Question Booklet.
 - c) Total duration of examination is 03 (three) hours.
 - d) Four (4) marks will be awarded for every Correct Answer and for every Wrong Answer, One (1) mark will be deducted.
 - e) No candidate will be allowed to leave the Examination Hall temporarily during the Examinations.
 - f) Candidate must sit in his/her allotted seat.
 - g) No candidate can leave the designated seat of the Examination Hall till end of the Examination.
 - h) Candidates need to maintain discipline before, during and after the examination in the examination centre.
 - i) Candidate should do all the necessary Rough Work on the Question Booklet in the space provided. The blank spaces and blank sheets attached at the end of the Question Booklet are to be used for rough calculations/works only.

- j) Drinking water bottle should be transparent, if carried inside the examination hall.
- k) The examination authority reserves the right to frisk the candidate at any moment in examination premises.
12. Candidate has to report immediately if the OMR Answer sheet received is found to be torn/damaged.
13. Permissible items inside the examination hall are-
- (i) Admit Card
 - (ii) Proof of identity
 - (iii) Black ball point pen
 - (iv) Transparent water bottle.

Candidate will have to keep all his/her belongings and materials (other than mentioned above) outside the Examination Centre/Premises at his/her own risk.

14. Candidate shall submit the signed copy of the Admit card and the OMR Answer Sheet to the invigilator before leaving the examination hall, failure to do so will automatically cancel his/her candidature.
15. Candidature of any candidate will be cancelled if s/he does not follow the guidelines and instructions and if s/he is found to adopt unfair means, in any form as noted by the invigilator/authority.
16. The decision of Assam Science and Technology University with regard to the conduct of the examination shall be final and binding to the candidate.
17. Candidate who does not have the minimum educational qualification and whose age is not within the prescribed limit as mentioned in the JMEE-2025 Information brochure, should not appear in the examination. The candidature of such candidate is invalid.
18. No candidate shall be allowed to enter the Examination Hall after commencement of Examination, i.e. after 11:00 A.M.

Weeding out rules

Records of JMEE-2025 will be kept till the completion of counselling of JMEE-2025.

Legal Jurisdiction

All disputes pertaining to the conduct of JMEE-2025 examination including results shall fall within the jurisdiction of Guwahati only.

4. Declaration of Results: results are expected in 15 working days
