### Ensuring Fair Representation in Zilla Parishads

- Cabinet has approved the amendment of certain provisions of the Assam Panchayat (Constitution) Rules, 1995
- The reservation of the offices of President/ Vice President of Zilla Parishad (ZP) shall be done by way of lottery and rotation after excluding the Zilla Parishad in which the office of the President/ Vice President has already been reserved for SC and ST by way of lottery & rotation
- This will ensure equitable opportunity for all the ZP constituencies having SC and ST population. The process of lottery will be conducted in a public and open manner in presence of representatives from political parties, administrative officials and all concerned stakeholders



### Allotment of Land under Mission Basundhara 3.0

- Cabinet has approved allotment of Govt land under Mission Basundhara 3.0 to
  - ▶ **942 infrastructure projects of various State Government Departments in urban areas across 11 districts**
  - ▶ **1,977 non-government educational, religious, and socio-cultural institutions across 12 districts**

### Empowering the Moran & Matak Communities

- Cabinet has approved the Moran Autonomous Council (Amendment) Ordinance, 2025, to amend the provisions of the Moran Autonomous Council Act, 2020 and the Matak Autonomous Council (Amendment) Ordinance, 2025, to amend the provisions of the Matak Autonomous Council Act, 2020
- As per the amendments, Moran Council Areas will include only the population belonging to the Moran community in the area notified by the State Government as Council Area, without affecting rights of people of other communities and also seeks to establish the Matak Autonomous Council by defining the Council Areas to include only the population belonging to the Matak community in the area notified by the State Government as Council Area
- The General Council of both the Autonomous Councils shall consist of 30 elected members out of which 5 seats shall be reserved for women of the communities
