Procedural Guidelines

BODOLAND OVERSEAS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME (BOSP)

1. Introduction

The Bodoland Overseas Scholarship Programme (BOSP) is an ambitious initiative of the Department of Education, Bodoland Territorial Council (BTC), to provide exceptional opportunities for the talented youth of the Bodoland Territorial Region (BTR). The program is aimed at fostering holistic development through access to high-quality education and research in the world's leading universities, including Ivy League institutions. The programme reflects the visionary leadership of Shri Pramod Boro, Hon'ble Chief Executive Member (CEM), and emphasises the commitment of the BTR Government to empower its youth and advance the education sector.

2. Vision

To create a globally competent and socially responsible pool of leaders, researchers, and professionals who contribute to the holistic development of Bodoland and beyond.

3. Mission

- I. To support and enable the brightest minds of BTR to access international-standard education and research opportunities.
- II. To cultivate a culture of excellence in academics and innovation within BTR.
- III. To encourage the return of talented individuals to contribute to the education, socioeconomic, and cultural advancement of the region.

4. Objectives

- I. To fund Undergraduate/Postgraduate (Master's)/Doctoral (PhD)/Post Doctoral Studies/an academic semester exchange studies between an Indian university and a foreign university in the top 500 world universities.
- II. To provide international exposure and develop globally competent leaders.
- III. To build a robust knowledge base for driving sustainable development in BTR.
- IV. To strengthen the education system within BTR by promoting excellence among educators and researchers.

5. Eligibility Criteria

- I. **Residency**: Applicants must be permanent residents of BTR.
- II. Educational Qualification:

- i. **For Undergraduate Studies:** A 12th passed with a minimum of 60% or equivalent CGPA.
- ii. *For Postgraduate Studies*: A Bachelor's degree with a minimum of 60% or equivalent CGPA.
- iii. *For Doctoral Studies*: A Master's degree with at least 55% or equivalent CGPA.
- iv. *For post-doctoral studies*: The candidate must have either recently submitted a PhD thesis or have completed a PhD within three years.
- v. The applicant must have received an official offer letter of admission from the host university or institution.

III. Income Criteria

i. Applicants are required to submit valid income certificates or equivalent documentation, issued by a competent authority to proof financial capability to support for their studies, in case of need.

IV. Age Limit:

- i. Undergraduate: Not exceeding 20 years
- ii. Postgraduate: Not exceeding 25 years.
- iii. Doctoral: Not exceeding 30 years.
- iv. Post-Doctoral: Not exceeding 40 years.
- V. **University Admission**: Secured admission or have obtained offer letter, preferably from one of the top 500 universities as per global rankings made by the following agencies:
 - i. QS: Quacquarelli Symonds
 - ii. **THE**: Times Higher Education
 - iii. ARWU: Academic Ranking of World Universities.
- VI. **Commitment**: Applicants must demonstrate a commitment to contributing to the development of BTR.

6. The Subjects and Slots covered by the Scheme

The following are the subjects/disciplines in which students can study abroad, as well as the number of slots available under each field for grant awards:

7. The scheme will support the following academic categories

- I. Undergraduate Courses
- II. Postgraduate Courses
- III. Doctoral Studies (Ph.D.)
- IV. Post-Doctoral Research
- V. Semester-based International Academic Exchange Programmes [between Indian (preferably institutes or universities in BTR) and foreign universities].

8. Duration of Award with Financial Aid

The scholarship provides a one-time grant, covering a minimum of one semester (typically 4–5 months) or more.

9. The Value of Scholarship

10. The scholarship will cover the following expenditure heads

- I. Tuition fees and related academic expenses
- II. Maintenance allowances
- III. Residential and hostel fees
- IV. Health insurance
- V. Visa fees
- VI. International and local travel
- VII. Printing and stationery

11. Application Process

I. **Notification**: The program will be announced on a rolling basis throughout the year by the Department of Education, BTC; however, the Managing Committee will review applications quarterly or as needed.

II. Submission: Applications must be submitted online through the official portal.

III. Required Documents:

- i. Proof of residency.
- ii. Academic transcripts and certificates.
- iii. Admission or an offer letter from a recognized overseas universities/institution.
- iv. Statement of Purpose (SOP).
- v. Research proposal (for doctoral and post-doctoral applicants).
- vi. One-pager statement of commitment to BTR development goals.

12. Selection:

- I. Applications will be evaluated by a committee of experts based on academic merit, research potential, and alignment with BTR's developmental goals.
- II. An interview will be conducted for under graduate and postgraduate applicants, while doctoral and post-doctoral applicants will present and defend their research proposals during a presentation-cum-interview process.

13. Terms and Conditions

- i. **Bond Agreement**: Recipients must sign a bond agreeing to work in or for the development of BTR for at least five years after the completion of their studies.
- ii. **Repayment Clause**: If a recipient fails to submit documentary evidences of successful completion of the course as per the bond agreement, the scholarship amount will be treated as a loan, repayable with interest.
- iii. **Academic Performance**: Recipients must maintain good academic standing as defined by the host university and must submit documentary evidences of successful completion of the program to the director of education.
- iv. **Reporting**: Annual/periodical progress reports must be submitted to the Director of Education, BTC.
- v. **Termination**: The scholarship will be terminated in cases of academic failure, misconduct, or breach of terms.

14. Monitoring and Evaluation

- i. **Tracking Progress**: The Department of Education will establish a monitoring committee to track the academic progress and contributions of recipients.
- ii. **Alumni Network**: Establish an alumni network to foster collaboration and mentorship among past and present scholars.

iii. **Impact Assessment**: Conduct periodic assessments to evaluate the program's impact on BTR's development.

15.Legal Provisions

- i. The Bodoland Overseas Scholarship Programme will be governed by the rules and regulations of the Bodoland Territorial Council.
- ii. Any disputes arising out of the scholarship scheme will be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts within BTR.
